## **Stanford Jazz Combos Fall 2022**

The Dept of Music offers jazz combo (Music 181) for 1 unit this fall. Groups rehearse once a week for 90 minutes, receive some coaching from professional players, and perform at the end of the quarter in the CoHo. Weekly rehearsal space w/ piano, drums, & amps is provided.

Depending on your schedule and level of jazz experience, you may fit into one of the beginning, intermediate or advanced groups that will be formed this fall.

Placement in a group depends primarily on the demands of instrumental balance and the availability of a match for you with others who are at a similar experience level and who are all able to rehearse at the same time when coaching is available. Most rehearsals are on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday evenings, but other times can work too.

- Rhythm section players (piano, bass, guitar, drums) will audition live at 6:15 on Tuesday September 27, 2022 in Braun Music Center room 105.
- all single line instruments (like trumpet, sax, trombone, vocal, violin, cello, flute, etc.) need to make recording on their phone or other device with the play-along tracks, and upload it by 6pm Tuesday September 27, 2022. Fill out *Jazz Combo Form 2022* to get the tracks & guidelines.

**No audition necessary for the Jazz Skills Combo** which meets Mondays from noon to 1pm in Braun Room 111, starting October 3. You must play an instrument and know all 12 major scales.
